

Per Capita Consumption of Fats and Oils in Food Products




Consumption of fats and oils in food products decreased by 2.3 pounds per capita in 2003 compared with the previous year. The 85.6 pounds consumed per person during 2003 computes to a 2.6% decrease compared with 2002, and marked the first year since 1996 that consumption of these products registered a decrease on a per capita basis. Moreover, consumption of fats and oils have increased in 12 out of the last 16 years. It should be noted that unusually large consumption increases for the baking/ frying and the salad/ cooking categories in 2000 coincided with a change in the data source. Census Bureau data was the source for these categories prior to 2000, while USDA, Economic Research Service estimates have been used thereafter. Thus, comparisons between the time periods for these categories and all food uses may not be appropriate due to changes in the methodology used to calculate per capita consumption.

The data depicted in the graph above are detailed in the table on page three of this bulletin. The graphs on pages 2 and 4 depict per capita consumption patterns for each category of fats and oils over the past 24 years. The March 2005 edition of Oil Crops Situation and Outlook Yearbook, published by the Economic Research Service, is the source for all data used in this bulletin.

Per Capita Consumption of Fats and Oils in Food Products: Butter




Per capita consumption of margarine decreased for the seventh consecutive year, and has not increased on a year-to-year basis since 1993. Moreover, margarine consumption per capita increased in only 6 years during the period depicted in the accompanying graph.

Margarine consumption in 2003 totaled 6.2 pounds per person, which was the lowest amount registered during the 1980 through 2003 period. 2003 consumption was only 54.4% of the 11.4 pounds per capita that was

recorded during 1980. Butter consumption per person for 2000 through 2003 remained virtually unchanged, with maximum year-to-year variation of 0.1 pounds. Over the 24 years depicted in the accompanying graph, butter consumption has ranged from a high of 4.9 pounds per capita during 1983-85 to a low of 4.1 pound in 1997. Per capita consumption of butter totaled 4.5 pounds during 2003.

Butter consumption in 2003 was 66.8% of margarine usage on a per capita basis. The average butter-to-margarine ratio during the 1980 through 2003 period was 47.8%, with a low of 37.9% in 1981 to a high of 67.6%


Per Capita Consumption of Fats and Oils in Food Products: Margarine



The trend in per capita consumption of fats and oils in salad and cooking has exhibited a persistent upward trend over the 24 years depicted in the graph to the left. The Economic Research Service estimate for 2003 for this category was 37.2 pounds per person, an increase of 3.5 pounds (+10.4%) compared with 2000.

Comparisons to years prior to 2000 may not be appropriate due to the data source changes previously noted. However, the trend of increasing per capita consumption of fats and oils in the salad/cooking category is prevalent during both periods covered by the different data sources.


Per Capita Consumption of Fats and Oils in Food Products: Salad / Cooking



Per capita consumption of fats and oils in the baking and frying category totaled 32.5 pounds in 2003, a decrease of 1.6 pounds (-4.7%) compared with 2002. However, consumption increased during the previous two years, with 2002 per person usage 8.9% higher than 2000 (34.1 versus 31.3 pounds per capita).

Even though comparisons to years prior to 2000 may not be appropriate due to data source limitations, the overall trend for this category has been one of increasing per capita consumption.


