The advanced prices and pricing factors will be released at 3:00 p.m. ET no later than the 23<sup>rd</sup> of the preceding month. If the release date does not fall on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, the most current release preceding the 23<sup>rd</sup> will be used in the price calculation. Likewise, the class and component prices will be released at 3:00 p.m. ET no later than the 5<sup>th</sup> of the following month. If the release date does not fall on the 5<sup>th</sup>, the most current release preceding the 5<sup>th</sup> will be used in the price calculation.
