⁽¹⁾ **Processor Assessment**: The processor assessment is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7 CFR § 1160.101 et seq.). The Order requires that all persons who process and market commercially more than 3,000,000 pounds of fluid milk products in consumer-type packages in the 48 contiguous States and the District of Columbia on a monthy basis, excluding those fluid milk products delivered to the residence of a consumer, be assessed 20 cents per hundredweight on all marketings of such packaged fluid milk products during the month.

The Central federal milk order No. 32 administrative assessment rate will be **WAIVED** for milk pooled during December 2010. The administrative assessment rate will revert back to 4.5¢ per hundredweight effective with January 2011 deliveries.

The marketing service assessment rate for Central federal milk order No. 32 nonmembers will remain at 6¢ per hundredweight.
