⁽¹⁾ **Processor Assessment:** The processor assessment is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7 CFR § 1160.101 et seq.). The Order requires that all persons who process and market commercially more than 3,000,000 pounds of fluid milk products in consumer-type packages in the 48 contiguous States and the District of Columbia on a monthly basis, excluding those fluid milk products delivered to the residence of a consumer, be assessed 20 cents per hundredweight on all marketings of such packaged fluid milk products during the month.

SUBJECT: Administrative Assessment Rate Change

The Central federal milk order No. 32 administrative assessment rate will be **WAIVED** for milk pooled during December 2011.

In addition, the administrative assessment rate will be **LOWERED** from the current 4.0¢ per hundredweight to 3.5¢ per hundredweight effective with January 2012 deliveries.

The marketing service assessment rate for Central federal milk order No. 32 nonmembers will remain at 6¢ per hundredweight.

Listed below are the release dates for the Federal milk order program for price data applicable to January through March 2012. The advanced prices and pricing factors will be released at 10:00 a.m. EST/EDST no later than the 23rd of the preceding month if that date is on a Friday; otherwise, the release date will be the nearest Friday before the 23rd. Likewise, the class and component prices will be released at 10:00 a.m. EST/EDST no later than the 5th of the following month if that date is on a Friday; otherwise the release date will be the nearest Friday before the 5th.
