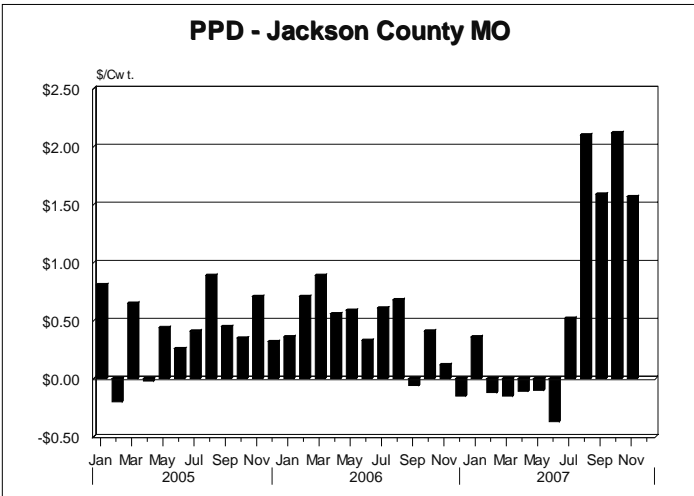

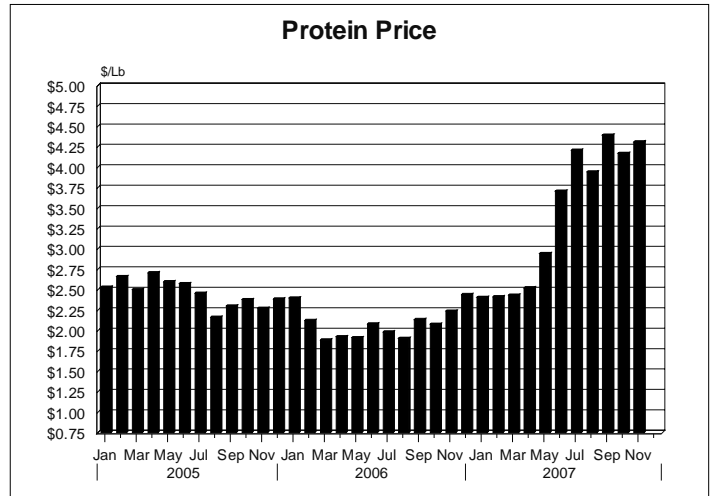

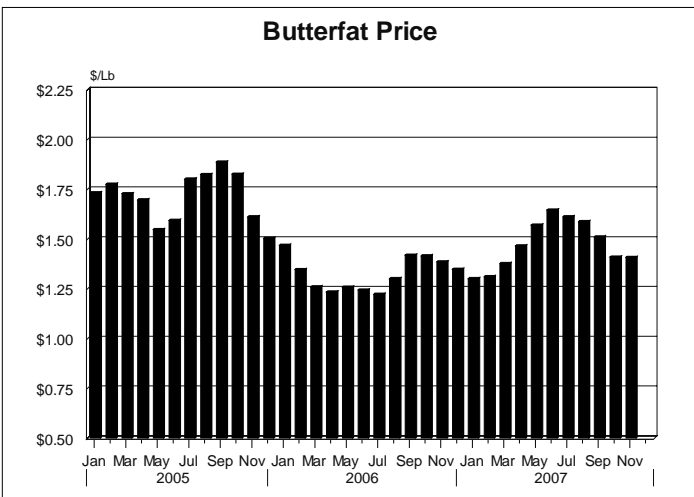
**CENTRAL FEDERAL ORDER No. 32 SELECTED MARKETING DATA FOR NOVEMBER 2007**



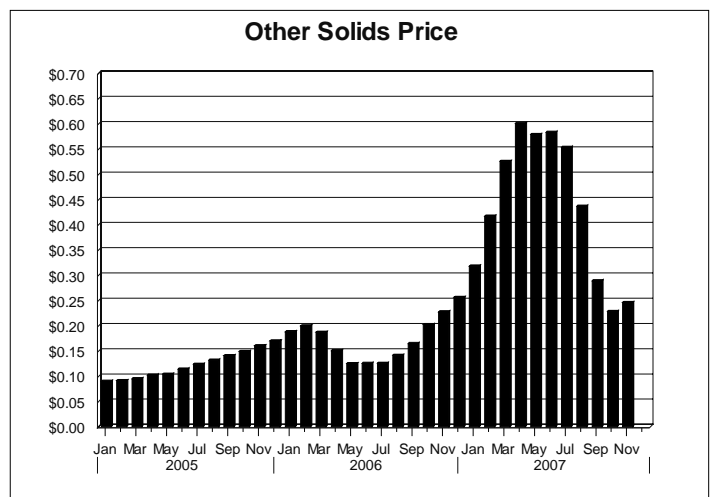
**Producer Price Differential:** The Central federal order Producer Price Differential at Jackson County MO was **\$1.57** per hundredweight during November 2007. The November PPD was **\$0.55 below** the previous month, but **\$1.45 above** November 2006. The November 2007 statistical uniform price was **\$20.79** and is published for informational purposes only.



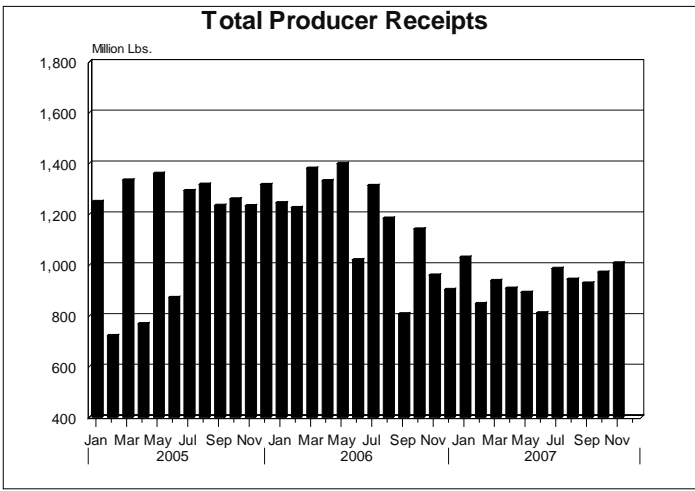
**Protein Price:** The November 2007 Protein Price was **\$4.3081** per pound which was **up \$0.1386** from the previous month, and **up \$2.0698** from November 2006. The average protein content of producer milk pooled on the order was **3.18** percent during November 2007.



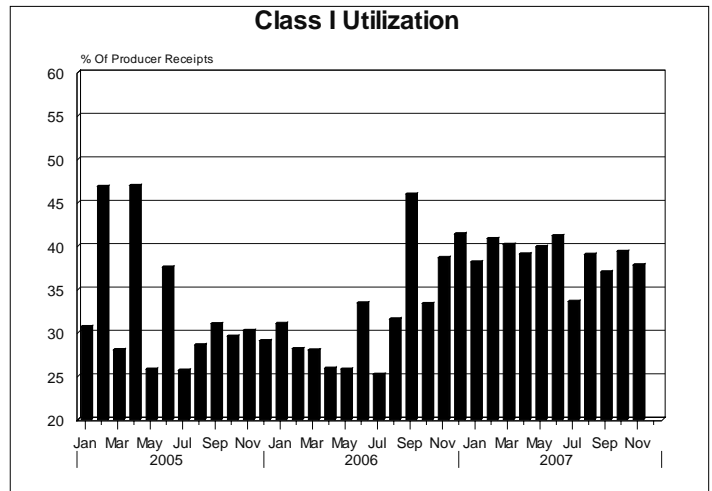
**Butterfat Price:** The November 2007 Butterfat Price was **\$1.4077** per pound which was **down \$0.0015** from the previous month, but **up \$0.0225** from November 2006. The average butterfat content of producer milk pooled on the order was **3.77** percent during November 2007.



**Other Solids Price:** The November 2007 Other Solids Price was **\$0.2461** per pound which was **up \$0.0175** from the previous month, and **up \$0.0185** from November 2006. The average other solids content of producer milk pooled on the order was **5.71** percent during November 2007.

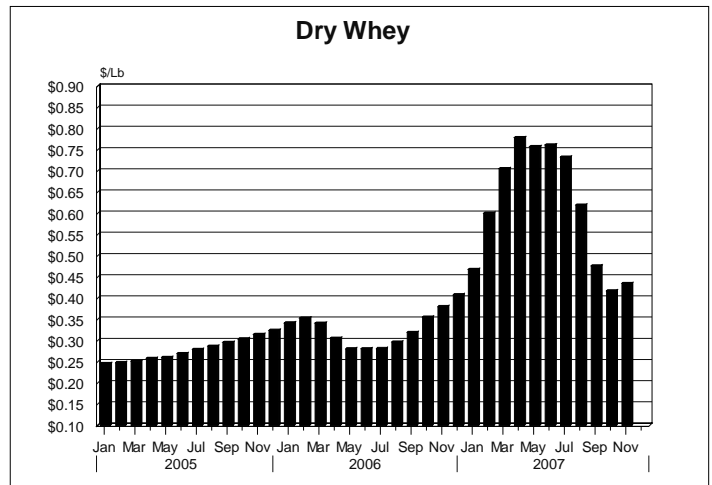
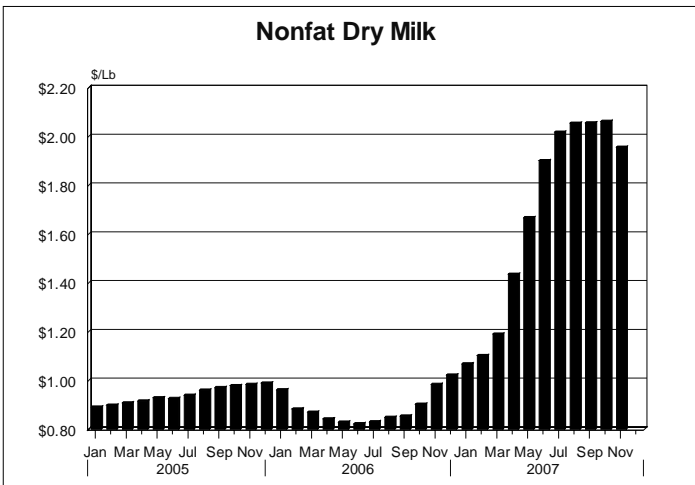
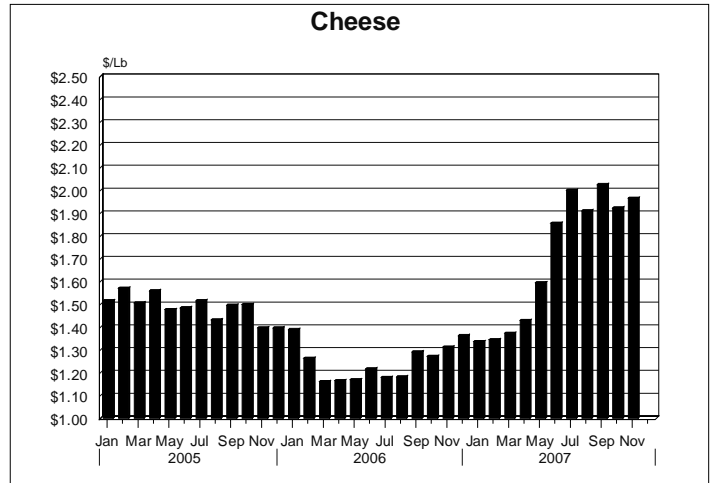
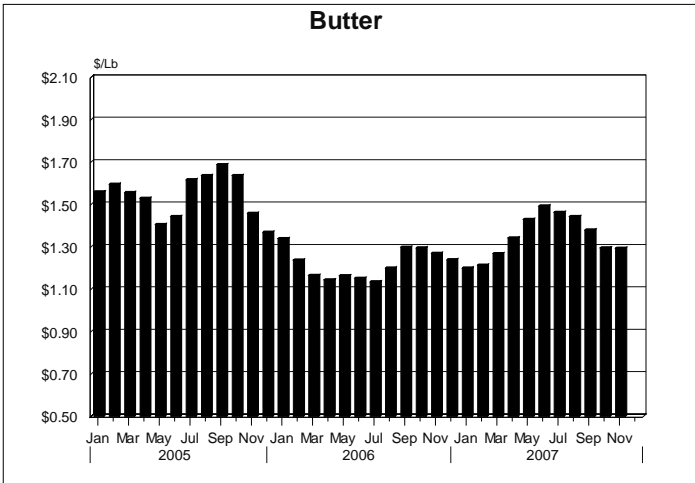


**Producer Receipts:** Total Grade "A" milk pooled on the Central federal order totaled **1,008.6** million pounds during November 2007. This was an **increase of 7.24** percent (daily basis) compared with **971.8** million pounds pooled during October 2007, and an **increase of 4.95** percent compared with **961.0** million pounds pooled during November 2006.



**Class I Utilization:** Producer milk utilized as Class I accounted for **37.81** percent of the total milk pooled on the Central federal order during November 2007. This compares with **39.38** percent during October 2007 and **38.66** percent during November 2006.
